# NORPAC NEWS & NOTES

**WEEKLY RECAP** - No. 9 Stanford, then-No. 14 California and Longwood came out on top in league contests last week. The Cardinal finished off a perfect 6-0 year with a 5-0 shutout against UC Davis. The Bears and Lancers used late comebacks for their victories.

California scored twice in the final minute and then won 10 minutes into overtime in a 3-2 thriller against the Aggies. Longwood rallied past Davidson as it scored in the 69th minute for a 3-2 win and to grab a two and a half game lead over the Wildcats in the standings.

**UPCOMING WEEK** - In the final week of the regular season, contests in both the east and west will determine the final seedings for the NorPac Tournament. In the west, UC Davis heads to Pacific holding a one-game lead for third place. On the eastern front, Davidson hosts Appalachian State and Radford, while Longwood welcomes the Mountaineers to Farmville.

In other action, No. 9 Stanford heads to Michigan for a pair of tests against No. 7 Michigan and Michigan State.

No. 16 California and UC Davis have wrapped up their regular seasons.

**WELCOME LIBERTY** - On Oct. 12, Liberty University accepted an invitation to become the ninth member of the NorPac Conference. The Lady Flames, who are in their first year of NCAA competition, will officially be a member of the league on July 1, 2012 and immediately be eligible of the NorPac Championships.

**HISTORY IN THE RANKINGS** - NorPac history was made in the rankings in week two when Stanford and California were ranked 9th and 11th, the highest since the NFCA poll was introduced in 1998. Stanford's climb continues to be the best ranking in league history.

**NORPAC IN THE RANKINGS** - Stanford and California rank 9th and 16th in this week's Kookaburra / NFCA Division I Coaches Poll.
