**Hope Burke I So. I Forward

Burke tallied two goals and an assist as No. 9 Stanford posted a pair of road wins over Big 10 opponents, Michigan State and No. 7 Michigan.

The sophomore striker scored a goal in each contest. Along with tallying the first goal, Burke also dished out an assist against the Big 10 champion Wolverines.

DEFENSIVE

**Ale Moss I R-Sr. I Goalkeeper
Stanford (New York, N.Y.)**

Moss produced two shutouts this past weekend as she made 15 saves, including nine against Big 10 champion, Michigan.

She opened the weekend with six saves at Michigan State on Friday and concluded it with one of her biggest performances of the season, registering a season-high nine against the Wolverines.

ROOKIE

**Shannon Herold I Freshman I MF
Stanford (Delta, B.C.)**

Herold found the cage in each game against Michigan State and No. 7 Michigan last weekend.

The rookie midfielder scored on her only two shots of the weekend which included a second half score against the Wolverines that gave the Cardinal a two-goal cushion.

NORPAC NEWS & NOTES

WEEKLY RECAP - Longwood defeated Appalachian State, 2-0, to clinch its first Division title since being eligible for tournament play in 2007. Also, Davidson earned the second seed in the East with a pair of home wins over Appalachian State and Radford.

In the west, No. 9 Stanford picked up a pair of 3-0 victories over Big Ten opponents, Michigan State and league champion, No. 7 Michigan. The pair of victories gave the NorPac a 5-4 record against the conference this season.

In divisional play, UC Davis topped Pacific, 4-1, in Stockton to claim the third seed for the NorPac Championship.

UPCOMING WEEK - The NorPac Championships will be held at Stanford from Nov. 3-5 on Varsity Turf Field. The host and ninth-ranked Cardinal and Longwood are the respective top seeds in the West and East divisions.

The winner of the tournament will host the winner of the Atlantic 10 tournament on Tuesday, Nov. 8 in a NCAA Play-In game.

AGAINST THE REST - The NorPac posted winning records against the Big 10 (5-4), NEC (7-4) and Ivy League (4-2), while going .500 versus the American East (3-3) and Atlantic 10 (5-5) conferences.

They also picked up nine victories over nationally ranked opponents, six against the CAA, along with two and one versus the BIG EAST and ACC, respectively.

ATLANTIC 10 TOURNAMENT - Taking a look at the NorPac's opponent in the NCAA Play-In game (Nov. 8), the Atlantic 10 will hold its 2011 tournament at St. Joseph's on Nov. 4 and 5. Richmond and UMass tied as regular season champions, but the Spiders earned the top seed via their victory over the Minutewomen.

Richmond will take on La Salle, while UMass will face off against Temple on Friday, with the Championship match being contested at 2 p.m. on Saturday.

WELCOME LIBERTY - On Oct. 12, Liberty University accepted an invitation to become the ninth member of the NorPac Conference. The Lady Flames, who are in their first year of NCAA competition, will officially be a member of the league on July 1, 2012 and immediately be eligible of the NorPac Championships.

HISTORY IN THE RANKINGS - NorPac history was made in the rankings in week two when Stanford and California were ranked 9th and 11th, the highest since the NFHCA poll was introduced in 1998. Stanford's climb to No. 6 was the best ranking in league history.
