NorPac CONFERENCE REPRESENTED BY TRIO AT 2004 NFHCA DIVISION I NORTH/SOUTH SENIOR ALL-STAR GAME

Stockton, Calif. – The Northern Pacific Field Hockey Conference (NorPac) will be represented by Gabby Gomez (Southwest Missouri State), Eleanor Morgan (Stanford) and goalkeeper Sarah Nolan (Davidson) at the annual National Field Hockey Coaches Association (NFHCA) North/South Senior All-Star game on Saturday, Nov. 20th at Wake Forest University in Winston-Salem, NC. The game is scheduled to begin at 7:30 p.m.

Entering the NorPac Championship tournament, Gomez leads Southwest Missouri State in goals (eight), assists (six), and points (22). Three of her goals were game winning goals. She was the NorPac West Division Offensive Player of the Week for October 5th. In addition, Gomez has two defensive saves this season.

Morgan leads Stanford this season with six assists and is third in points scored at ten. Morgan had her biggest game of the season in a 5-0 win at Iowa (9/10), scoring a goal and assisting on two others and also tallying in her final regular season game on The Farm against Pacific (10/23). Morgan has played in 70 career games and made 63 starts, including a current streak of 56 in a row that encompasses every game of her sophomore, junior and senior campaigns.
