Around the NorPac

Appalachian State

Goalkeeper **Denise Adams** made 12 saves in the Mountaineers' game vs. Longwood. ASU will head to Davidson for a non-conference matchup on Wednesday.

California

Cal will play its third top-10 team this season when it hosts Michigan. In the last meeting between Michigan and Cal, the Wolverines won 3-2 in Berkeley. Cal is 2-4 against ranked opponents this season. Senior **Jennifer Crane** tied a career high with her eighth goal of the season against Pacific. Sophomore **Kelli York** scored her career high third goal of the season vs. the Tigers.

Davidson

Longwood

The Lancers snapped a four-game skid with a League victory at Appalachian State on Sunday. It was the last East Coast contest for LU as it heads to California to take on the Bears in its regular season finale on Oct. 30.
