**Appalachian State**

The Mountaineers dropped a close 2-1 match at Davidson on Sunday after not seeing action since Oct. 7 ... The Mountaineers will be the sixth seed at the NorPac Tournament.

**Cal**

Cal will hit the road for its final game of the regular season with a non-conference game at Stanford ... The Bears will be doing some scoreboard watching this weekend to see where they finish the regular season; in a tie for first or second.

**Davidson**

The Wildcats picked up their first Conference victory of the season with a 2-1 win over Appalachian State ... Davidson will be the fifth seed in the NorPac Tournament.

**Longwood**

Longwood will play a pair of games on the road to close out its regular season at Davidson and vs. Lock Haven at Davidson.

**Pacific**

Pacific can clinch the NorPac regular season title and a first round bye in the Conference Tournament with a victory over Radford on Oct. 29 in its regular season finale.

**Radford**

The Highlanders close out their regular season with a pair of key Conference matches at Pacific and Stanford ... Radford can still finish anywhere from a tie for first to fourth.

**Stanford**

Stanford will play its final two regular season games at home against Cal and Radford ... the game against the Highlanders will determine if the Cardinal finishes third or fourth.
