2007 NEWS AND NOTES

Around the NorPac

Appalachian State

Freshman Nicole Morgan scored her team high fourth goal of the season against Rider.

California

Cal picked up its first win of the season with a 1-0 victory over Missouri State last Monday.

The Bears received six points in the current STX/NFHCA Division I National Coaches Poll.

Davidson

Senior Kayli Maxwell is tied for the NCAA lead with eight goals and leads the NCAA in points per game with 4.25. Her 17 points are third best in the country.

Longwood

Longwood collected its first win of the season with a 3-1 victory over Rider. Two of the Lancers' next three matches will be NorPac battles at home with Radford and California.

Pacific

The Tigers were off last week and are making a trip to New England for three matches in New Hampshire and Massachusetts. It will be a homecoming for head coach Linda MacDonald. She graduated from Springfield (Mass.) College and coached at Westford Academy in Westford, Mass. and Bentley College (Waltham, Mass.).

Radford

Radford put together a strong effort against No. 8 Duke on Sunday. The Highlanders were in the match until Duke tallied a pair of goals in the final five minutes. They peppered the Blue Devils with 10 shots, but were unable to find the back of the cage as Duke's keeper made eight saves. Freshman Jennifer Wisniewski kept RU in the match making a career high 10 saves.

Stanford

With a 6-0 start, Stanford has entered the top 20 of the STX/NFHCA Coaches Poll at No. 19.

After an undefeated three-match Conference road swing, Stanford is off to its best start (6-0) since 1979 when it started 5-0. The Cardinal did not record their sixth victory until Oct. 12 last season.

On the trip, Stanford out scored its opponents, 13-1. For the season, they have out scored their opponents, 22-5 and out shot them, 128-38.
