2007 NEWS AND NOTES

Around the NorPac

Appalachian State

Ali Gradischer had a two-goal match against Drexel on Sunday, tying her for a team high three goals on the season.

California

Cal extending its winning streak to four matches after going 3-0 on its recent NorPac swing to Davidson, N.C.

After scoring just three goals in their first three games, the Golden Bears exploded for eight goals against Appalachian State.

Andrea Lo is now tied for sixth with Teela Crosthwaite for career assists (17) and Rachel Moffitt is tied for eighth (16). Senior Jennifer Crane ranks eighth on Cal's all-time goal scoring list with 24 and has the ninth most career points (52).

Davidson

Senior Kayli Maxwell was involved in all three goals, including the game-winning stroke, in Davidson's 3-2 double OT win over Longwood. She currently ranks first nationally in goals per game (1.5) and is second in points per game (3.5).

Longwood

Avanell Schmitz has anchored the Lancer defense, posting a NCAA best 76 saves and also helped Longwood record its first shutout of the season against Radford.

Katie Claxton tallied three goals this week, including two in the Lancers' 3-0 win over Radford.

Pacific

Freshman goalkeeper Lauren Woods made 15 saves during Pacific's trip to New England. Of those saves, three were on strokes. She saved two against Vermont and one at New Hampshire.

Radford

Freshman Kay Tufts scored her first collegiate goal against No. 5 Wake Forest on Wednesday.

Junior Erica Lawrence tallied the equalizer and also assisted on RU's first goal against Cal. She currently leads Radford with eight points.

Stanford

At 6-0, Stanford is currently ranked 20th in the STX/NFHCA Coaches Poll. Last week, it marked the first time since 2001 the Cardinal were in the top 20.

The Cardinal lead the nation in corners per game (11.5). They return to action on Sunday to face California in a NorPac tilt.
