**California and Stanford Share NorPac Regular Season Championship;  
Cal Claims Top Seed at Tournament**

**RADFORD, Va.** – California and Stanford shared the 2007 NorPac regular-season championship with the Golden Bears claiming the top seed and a first round bye at this week's NorPac Tournament in Stanford, Calif.

Stanford and Cal each finished the regular season with 5-1 NorPac records. The Bears claimed the top seed by virtue of their 2-1 win over the Cardinal during the regular season. It is their ninth straight season claiming at least a share of the regular season title. For the Cardinal, it is their second consecutive year as the second seed.

Pacific will be the third seed, finishing the season with a 4-2 record, followed by Davidson with a 3-3 record. Longwood and Radford tied for fifth with 2-4 records. The Lancers earned the fifth seed after a 3-0 victory over the Highlanders this season. Appalachian State (0-6) rounds out the seeding at No. 7.

The NorPac Championship, hosted by Stanford, will begin on Thursday, Nov. 1 with three first round games and concludes with the Championship game at 2:30 pm on Saturday, Nov. 3.

No. 4 and No. 5 Longwood will open up the tournament at 10 am, followed by No. 3 vs. No. 6 Radford at 12:30 pm. No. 2 Stanford and No. 7 Appalachian State close out the first day at 3:00 pm. No. 1 Cal, who earned a first round bye, will play its first game on Friday, Nov. 2 at 12:30 pm.

The winner of the Championship game will host the winner of the Northeast Conference Tournament in a NCAA play-in game on Tuesday, Nov. 6.
