# Around the NorPac

**Appalachian State**  
Mikayla Paulson is tied for 19th in NCAA in saves (7.00).  
The Mountaineers will face a pair of League foes on the road this week. They face Davidson in a mid-week non-conference match and then head to Radford for a League tilt on Saturday.

**California**  
The Bears moved up two spots in the NFHCA rankings to No. 13. It ties them for their highest ranking which they also achieved on Oct. 5, 2004. This is their best start since 2004 when they started 6-2.

Senior Valentina Godfrid and sophomore Ashley Glosz are ranked nationally. Godfrid is tied for fifth in goals per game (1.25) and tied for eighth in points per game (3.0). Glosz is tied for 18th in goals (0.88) and tied for 25th in points (2.13). Cal ranks tied for 14th in scoring at 3.25 gpg.

**Davidson**  
Sophomore Brittany Rollek is ninth in the NCAA in saves (8.29) and 11th in save percentage (.817).

The Tigers return home for a pair of matches this week, hosting Appalachian State in a non-conference matchup and Albany.

**Longwood**  
The Lancers' 3-2 victory over Virginia Commonwealth was their first over the Rams since 1999.

Longwood will head to Baltimore this weekend for a pair of games against UMBC and Rider.

**Pacific**  
Senior Vianney Campos broke her own school records for single-season points and goals in the Tigers' game against Cal. She currently has 15 goals and 32 points, surpassing her 2004 totals of 14 goals and 31 points.

She leads the country averaging 3.56 points per game and 1.67 goals per game. Pacific ranks tied for 28th in the nation at 2.67 goals per game.

**Radford**  
Junior Megan Longtain tallied her first multi-goal game with a pair in a 3-1 won at Robert Morris on Friday. She currently leads RU with three goals. The Highs have had nine different players score goals for them this season.

The Highs rank eighth in nation at 8.75 penalty corners per game.  
Radford will host Appalachian State this Saturday in its home and Conference opener.

**Stanford**  
Madison Bell is ranked 25th in the NCAA in saves (6.56).  
Stanford jumps into Conference play this week with a pair of matches. Their NorPac opener is at Pacific on Sept. 21, followed by a home League match against No. 13 Cal on Sunday.
