2006 NEWS AND NOTES

Around the NorPac

Appalachian State

The Mountaineers picked up their first win of the season with a 3-0 blanking at home against Catawba.

Junior Mikayla Paulson is ranked 24th in saves per game.

California

The Bears moved up a spot in the NCFHA Poll to 13th after a 2-0 week, that included a victory over then No. 13 Louisville.

With her seven-goal week, senior Valentina Godfrid is now ranked second in the country in both goals (22) and points (49).

Davidson

Sophomore Brittany Rollek is ranked tied for 13th in the NCAA in saves.

The Wildcats conclude their west coast swing on Tuesday against Pacific. They return home for a Sunday tilt with Radford.

Longwood

The Lancers will travel to No. 16 James Madison for their lone match this week.

Junior Erin West is nationally ranked in saves.

Pacific

Senior Vianney Campos has scored in eight of the Tigers' last nine games.

With two victories last week, head coach Linda McDonald has reached 95 career wins (58 at Pacific).

Pacific's win over Radford marked the fourth straight one-goal match between the schools and fifth overall in six matches. It was the second straight OT match (third overall), and the second to go into strokes. The victory evened the series at 3-3.

Radford

In Saturday's match against Pacific, senior Kiera Gambeski had two defensive saves to move her into second on the career charts with 12, three shy of the record held by Angela Feindt (2001-04). Also, senior Tiffany Church had a pair of assists to bring her career total to 18, which is third at RU and five off the record held by Sue Neal (1983-86).

Stanford

The Cardinal will honor their seniors when they host Appalachian State on Thursday. It will be the final home game for Katherine Brooks, Liz Robinson, Jamie Hais, Julia Drewes and Aska Sturdevan.
